

MDSCRIPTS AUTOMATES ZERO REPORTING FOR ALABAMA AND CALIFORNIA PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING PROGRAMS

MDScripts now automatically submits Zero Reports for providers in the states of Alabama and California. Some states with Prescription Drug Monitoring Programs (PDMP's) require dispensing practitioners to file a zero (or 'no fill') report if there has not been any controlled dispensing activity over the reporting period (typically 7 days). Effective immediately, MDScripts will monitor and automatically submit a zero reports on behalf of the providers in Alabama and California. To see statistics on last filed zero report and last dispense date of a controlled substance, visit the Zero Reporting screen under the My Site menu in the system. The automatic zero reporting is only performed for active dispensing sites.

We will be adding automated zero reporting in other states where permissible by law. Automated zero reporting is more efficient and reliable for a practice, and will assist providers in maintaining compliance with state PDMP reporting regulations.
